#### 2023 Coach & Manager Information Session Committee Charter



- The committee will ALWAYS work for what it believes is in the best interests for the PLAYERS in the Club greatest good for the greatest number.
- The Committee will ALWAYS support the Coach and Manager if parents/players/spectators are a problem

#### All players must have at all times

- Football Boots (except preseason)
- Shinpads (training and matches)
- Matches Team Uniform comprising:
  - ✓ Rovers Socks (White)
  - ✓ Rovers Shorts (White for Mixed, Blue for Women's)
  - ✓ Club playing strip
- Fines apply for teams not wearing appropriate uniform items
- ☐ No jewellery, no tape to cover etc

- 1. Collect your kit (kit bag and ball bag) on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> March 9:00am-12:00pm at the equipment shed. Kit contains:
  - Playing strip
  - Training bibs (usually enough for half the squad)
  - Goalie gloves (U8-U16 teams, adult sizes available if needed)
  - Player of the week Trophy (U6-U9 teams only)
  - Balls one match ball, training balls and cones
- 2. Check your kit bag (preferably before you leave the park) If the items highlighted on the bag tag do not match the contents of the kit (especially jerseys), please let the Equipment team know immediately.

## 2023 Coach & Manager Information Session Equipment – During the season



- 1. Allocate a jersey to each player.
  - Match jerseys to players by size, not by players favourite number. Small numbers = smaller sizes. Highest numbers = largest sizes. If larger sizes are needed, please contact the Equipment team.
- 2. **Make a list** of who has which jersey number, and which jerseys are spare. Keep spare jerseys safely in kit.
- 3. **Jerseys are to be worn to the game only.** If going out after the game, players are to change out of jersey.
- 4. Jerseys to be washed in cold water. Do not tumble dry.
- 5. If you need replacement balls or any other issued equipment during the season, contact the Equipment team. We're here to help!!
- 6. If a player leaves mid-season, please collect their jersey as a priority!

## 2023 Coach & Manager Information Session Equipment – End of Season



- 1. On the lead up to the last game, remind players to bring a shirt to change after the game, and take the jerseys home and PLEASE WASH all together, including the bibs.
- 2. Prepare the kit for collection day. Check that all equipment issued is collected and ready for return. Arrange all jerseys and bibs neatly folded in half in a pile, with jersey number facing upward, and stacked in ascending order. Check bag tag to make sure nothing is missing.
- 3. Return kit on nominated kit return day. You will be notified by email. If you cannot make the day, please give to another team member to return.
- 4. Please do not return anything that is not issued by the club. We do not want:

Grass (please empty the bag and turn over and shake out all grass), Used band-aids, Drink bottles, Rubbish, Team sheets, whistles, busted or broken balls (please throw these out before returning the ball bag) ......you get the point!

Pretty simple – please return the kit bag as you would like to receive it. Neat, CLEAN, complete.

Any player who does not return a jersey will either need to pay for the jersey, or will be deemed "unfinancial" and not able to play in the competition.

#### 2023 Coach & Manager Information Session Behaviour and Codes of Conduct



Agreement to accept and abide by the FFA, FNSW, NWSF & WRRFC Codes of Conduct FFA, FNSW, NWSF and WRRFC will not tolerate any abuse, bullying, racist or belittling remarks to or from any player, spectator or referee
WRRFC has a zero tolerance on sideline and referee abuse.  Coaches and Managers have the power and authority, and are expected to address players/parents that are becoming overzealous. Any such behaviour must be reported to the Club Secretary/relevant coordinators immediately.
Bans of up to 30 years may be levelled against players/parents for any abusefrom ALL football.
Ensure you read the Code of Conduct documents and distribute them to players and parents. Ignorance is no excuse.

## 2023 Coach & Manager Information Session PlayFootball Dribl



- ☐ Every Player, Coach and Manager must be registered in Play Football, and players must be fully paid in order to play.
- ☐ Those not registered OR without a current photo will not be eligible to play.
- All teams use Dribl
  - ✓ Under 10 up use e-teamsheets to manage players AND record scores.
  - √ Managers MUST ensure team sheets are filled out correctly
  - √ NO duplicated shirt numbers, take care with players playing up
  - ✓ MINIS U6-9 are to enter scores for all matches via iScores on mobile app

☐ Insurance — is now all online, no manual claim forms — FNSW.com.au

☐ Member Protection - ALL coaches and managers of U6-U18 teams need to provide a current WWC number. MUST be submitted before the season commences.

# 2023 Coach & Manager Information Session Coach & Manager responsibilities



- ☐ Responsible for young children
- ☐ Never leave Coach alone with child/children
- ☐ Never leave a child alone at the grounds
- Player Assessment Sheets. (see example)
- Coach Education Compulsory and voluntary (recommended)

## 2023 Coach & Manager Information Session Coaches Education – (2/4)



#### In 2023 the DOC's agreed to have all:

- ☐ U6 to U8 coaches certified with a Miniroos certificate
- ☐ U9 to U12 coaches certified with a Skills Training certificate
- □ U13 to U18 (Division 1 and 2) certified with a Game Training certificate
- ☐ Super League and Premier League coaches certified with a Senior
  - Certificate, or C License
- ☐ This applies to male, mixed and female team coaches

## 2023 Coach & Manager Information Session Coaches Education – (3/4)



#### Why?

- ☐ To increase the quality of our player's football experience. This is the number one reason why people choose to stay/leave our game
- ☐ To increase the quality of our coaching. This is the core driver for the football experience and the number 2 reason why people stay/ leave
- ☐ To increase the quality of development of our players in our sport

## 2023 Coach & Manager Information Session Coaches Education – (4/4)



#### Why?

- ☐ To increase the enjoyment levels and longevity of those in coaching positions
- ☐ To decrease the need for time spent on getting coaches to coaching courses from both clubs and associations
- ☐ To engage high level young players in our Premier League and Super League competitions.

  - ✓ DO NOT post photos with names of players under age of 18 without express written consent of the players parents/guardians and WRRFC
